


ASSISTED VOLUNTARY RETURN AND REINTEGRATION (AVRR) BULLETIN 2017/II (APRIL-JUNE 2017)



NUMBER OF AVRR BENEFICIARIES, PER MONTH I JANUARY - 30 JUNE 2017, IN COMPARISON WITH 2016




Figures presented in this Bulletin show a decrease in the number of AVRR beneficiaries in the first semester of 2017, as compared to the same period in 2016. This is mainly due to a lower volume from the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland.


This decrease can be explained by a combination of structural and contextual factors, varying from country to country: lower influx of migrant arrivals and asylum applications; increase in the number of migrants in vulnerable situation (whose processing requires more time); and changes in national migration and asylum policies, including increased emphasis on forced returns or restrictions in AVRR eligibility criteria.


TOP 10 HOST COUNTRIES FOR AVRR 1 JANUARY - 30 JUNE 2017, IN COMPARISON WITH 2016
